## The Village of Wilbur Park Saint Louis County, MO 63123 August 19th, 2025 Meeting Minutes

- The meeting was called to order at 7:02 PM by Chairman Vohsen. Board Members Neal Vohsen, JC Wheeler, Ryan Richardson, and Abigail Richardson. Joined by Attorney Robert Paster and Officer Cecilia Young. Quorum met.
- Commissioner Richardson moved to approve July's meeting minutes. Minutes accepted.
